


Stainless Steel Farmhouse Kitchen Sinks Installation Guide

CFS30, CFS33, CFS36, DFS33, DFS36



Before You Begin

IMPORTANT

- Read and understand this installation guide completely before installation. It will increase the chance of a successful installation.
- It is recommended that the installation be performed by trained and experienced installers.
- Observe all local plumbing and building codes.
- Make sure the installation site is clean and free of dust and debris.
- Unpack and inspect the sink from the package for shipping damage and make sure all parts are included with the sink.
- The base cabinet should be at least 3 inches larger than the actual size of the sink.
- Keep the sink in its package until you are ready to install.

CAUTION

Risk of personal injury! Stainless steel edges are sharp and can cause severe cuts.
 Wear gloves and eye protection when handling and installing the sink.




Installation

IMPORTANT

- The base cabinet should be at least 3" wider than the actual size of the farmhouse sink.
- Always check the cutout template against the actual sink dimensions to ensure the correct cutout size.
- Allow enough clearance for the installation of faucet, backsplash and plumbing pipes, etc.
- 1. It is recommended to install the kitchen sink with a positive reveal. The sink rim is about 1/2" revealed around from the edge of the countertop.




2. Place the cutout template on the countertop to determine the proper placement of the sink. Cut the countertop after finalize the sink position.




Installation (cont.)


3. Measure the height of the front apron. Add 1/16" to the measurement and mark it on the front of the cabinet. Cut the front face of the cabinet.




4. Flip the countertop over and place the sink on the countertop in the appropriate position. Mark the mounting holes on the under side of the countertop. **NOTE:** The mounting holes should be 1/2" from the edge of the sink and evenly spaced out along the sides and backside of the sink as shown in the diagram



5. Drill 1/2" deep holes as marked on the countertop. Use a small hammer or mallet lightly tap in the anchors.




6. Apply a bead of silicone adhesive around the rim of the sink and position it to the cutout opening on the countertop. Press firmly to secure the sink to the countertop. **NOTE:** Always check the alignment and carefully lower it to countertop.



Installation (cont.)

7. Attach mounting brackets to the secure the sink in place. Wipe off excess adhesive from inside and outside of the sink bowl. Let the adhesive to cure for at least 45 minutes before install the countertop to the base cabinets. Connect the drain and install kitchen faucet to complete the installation.



Maintenance Guide

- 1. Any acidic food residue must be cleaned up immediately. For example, juices, salt, muster, salad dressing, etc.
- Regular cleaning can keep the original appearance of the sink. Use a mild detergent such as liquid dishwashing soap and warm water for cleaning. Rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove any cleaner residue and towel dry the sink immediately
- 2. Some discoloration spots are caused by hard water or household substances. These spots can be removed with special cleaning / polish products specifically for stainless steel.
- 3. Carefully read the cleaner product label to ensure the cleaner is safe for use on the material.
- 4. Do not use abrasive / harsh chemical when cleaning the product as they will damage and dull the finish.

 Avoid chlorine based solution from coming in contact with the stainless steel.
- 5. When using spray cleaners, spray first onto a soft cloth or sponge. Never spray directly onto the surface.
- 6. Never use steel wool or scrubbing powder to clean the surface. The stainless steel surface can get scratched and rust may developed at the damaged area.

Limited Lifetime Warranty (For USA Only)

The manufacturer warrants this product to be free of manufacture defects during daily normal household use for as long as it is owned by the original purchaser of this product. Please keep a copy of the original invoice as proof of purchase. This warranty is non-transferable.
